**Angel Gifts:** We are incredibly grateful to our Honey Tree Families for the very generous gift donations! All items are due by Monday, December 4th.

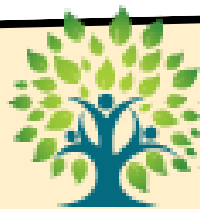
**Brenda Russett Photography** If you haven't ordered your pictures yet, there's still time! Brenda takes late orders.
